### FULL TEXT COVERAGE

Ariel WebInsight contains English language full text of major chemical laws, regulations and governmental agency guidelines related to EH&S legislation throughout the region in addition to English language legislative abstracts for several central and eastern

European countries. All chemical substances in the database lists are made available in both English and the native language of the regulation. Regulatory notes are provided in English and the native language of the regulation, where available.

### EU LEGISLATION

European Union law is not published as a unified code, but consists instead of multiple directives, decisions and regulations. An EU directive may have been amended 20 or 30 times. Finding the complete and current state of the legislation can be a challenge.
