OVERVIEW

FULL TEXT COVERAGE

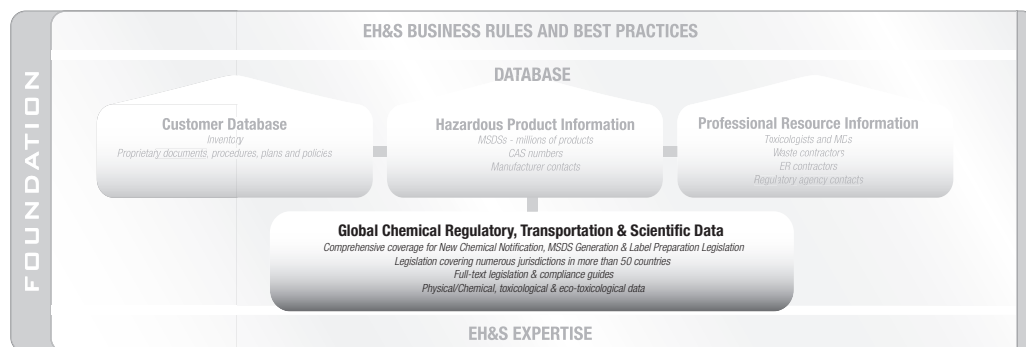
